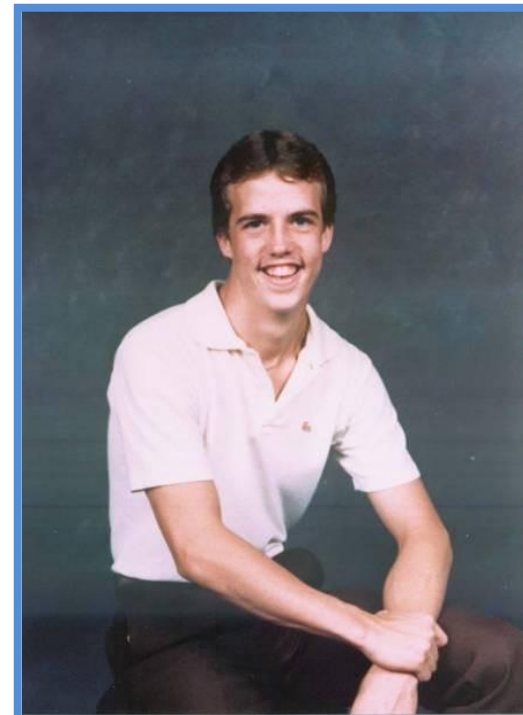

The Memorial Sign

Above is the replica of my brother David's sign. All of the signs will say Drunk Driving Victim! The next line will be the victim's initials, and the month and year they were killed. At the bottom of all the signs will have the words - Think About It!

Per the request of the victim's family and approval from MODOT the sign will be placed at or near each accident location.

If only one person chooses not to drive after drinking, the mission will be accomplished.
